Data Protection Statement

The Eight Data Protection Principles.

Personal Information:

- Shall be processed fairly and lawfully and shall not be processed unless specific conditions are met;
- Shall be obtained only for one or more specified and lawful purposes, and shall not be further processed in any manner incompatible with that purpose of those purposes;
- Shall be adequate, relevant and not excessive in relation to the purpose or purposes for which they are processed;
- Shall be accurate and where necessary kept up to date;
- Shall not be kept any longer than is necessary for that purpose of those purposes;
- Shall be processed in accordance with the rights of data subjects under the Act;
- Appropriate technical and organisational measures will be taken against unauthorised or unlawful processing of personal data and against accidental loss or destruction of, or damage to, personal data;
- Shall not transfer personal data to a country or territory outside of the United Kingdom unless that country or territory ensures an adequate level of protection for the rights and freedoms of data subjects in relation to the processing of personal data.
